Arthur & Friends Make a Musical opens Rose 2023-24 Season

Popular PBS characters take the stage at The Rose

(OMAHA, Nebr.) The Rose Theater kicks off the 2023-24 season with *Arthur & Friends Make a Musical*, playing Sept. 8 - 24, 2023 on The Rose Mainstage. Adapted from the popular books and characters created by Marc Brown, *Arthur & Friends Make a Musical* features the beloved characters, catchy music, colorful costumes and fun sets, making it the perfect back-to-school adventure for families.

Director Jackie Kappes explains, "The central theme of this show is that each of us has a unique story, and the show, the world, is better with those unique stories in them."

The Rose is one of the first theaters in the country to perform the new musical. "It is an honor that The Rose gets to bring this production to our community," says Rose artistic director Matt Gutschick.

Like the long-running PBS animated series, *Arthur & Friends Make a Musical* stars Arthur, his family and friends as they work together to creatively solve problems, learn to get along and appreciate each other's differences. Audiences will discover that big things are happening at Lakewood Elementary School – Mr. Ratburn's class is asked to write and perform a big show for all of Elwood City. Everyone is so excited – everyone, that is except Arthur (played by Corbin Griffin), who worries that he isn't as talented or creative as the rest of his classmates. What should he do? Arthur feels more and more nervous as the big performance gets closer and closer. With the help of his family and friends Arthur learns the importance of being his best, unique self.

Arthur & Friends Make a Musical is based on the books and characters created by Marc Brown with book and lyrics by John Maclay and music and lyrics by Brett Ryback. Featuring a bespectacled and beloved aardvark named Arthur, the series has been a mainstay of children's programming on PBS, the longest-running animated children's show in history starting in 1996 and running its final, 250th episode in 2022. Throughout its run, the series encouraged reading and relationships with family and friends by explaining that people have different personalities and interests.

Each of Arthur's friends brings a unique twist to the show. As Kappes explains, "This show is silly! We get to see wacky, imaginative stories come to life in unexpected ways and the cast has a blast portraying these iconic characters." For example, Arthur's little sister, D.W. (played by Lux Tipton) is obsessed with aliens; Muffy (Sydney Sweeney) is concerned with social issues; Francine (Natalie Hanson) is all about high fashion; best friend Buster (Brannon Evans) loves a mystery; while Brain (Isaiah Ruiz) brings, well, the brains to the mix.

Audiences can look forward to a toe-tapping time with original music that observant theater-goers will appreciate as nods to popular productions. "We were really drawn to the fact that **Arthur & Friends Make a Musical** pulls inspiration from a lot of familiar shows – *Hamilton, Les Mis, Chicago*. It just references a lot of different musicals and is a great introduction to a variety of musical theater forms," says Gutschick.

The set and costumes of **Arthur & Friends Make a Musical** are also highlights of this production, with many references to the television show and books – plus a little onstage magic – as the characters delve into their imaginations. "We have such fun with costumes in this show, from over the top fashion looks to snazzy rock and roll numbers," says Kappes. "The set also works in some unexpected and fun ways!"

"While this show is a blast, it also has a really meaningful journey for Arthur who is trying to find and share his own unique story," says Kappes. "Hopefully this show is like getting a warm hug while hearing a ridiculous joke from one of your favorite aardvarks."

Arthur & Friends Make a Musical runs Sept. 8 - 24, 2023. The 60-minute show is appropriate for all audiences. Shows are Fridays at 7 pm, Saturdays at 2 and 5 pm, and Sundays at 2 pm. Services for audiences with special needs, including interpretation for the Deaf and audio description services will be offered at the 2 pm show on Saturday, Sept 23. This showing will also be a sensory-friendly performance.
