Classic fairy tale takes on a new twist in two-person production at the Rose

(OMAHA, Nebr.) What happens when a familiar fairy tale takes an unexpected twist? Audiences will find out when *Red Riding Hood* comes to The Rose stage. In this hilarious adaptation by Allison Gregory, two actors play every character in the classic story.

In the production, which opens March 22 at The Rose, Wolfgang -- the self-proclaimed greatest actor in the world -- is interrupted when a delivery person arrives with a mysterious package. Two actors -- Rose Artist Educators Carina DuMarce and Rachel Smart -- take on all the roles in this furiously fast, funny, and surprising adaptation that asks what it means to bravely write your own story. The show is filled with interactive moments that will get everyone in on the story.

"This is a zany take on the material, not totally unlike *The Play That Goes Wrong* in that we have comedic mishaps and redos along the way," says Rose Artistic Director Matthew Gutschick. "This is a funny and lighthearted take on the material, with none of the scary overtones of the original Grimm fairy tale. Families can expect to have a really great time."
