The Rose Theater celebrates 75 years of family fun in 2024-25

Nebraska's only professional children's theater announces upcoming season

(OMAHA, NE) After 75 years of serving area families, The Rose Theater is looking forward to building on its legacy of outstanding entertainment with a season of fun and lifelong memories. A mix of familiar favorites, stories with local ties, and world premieres will invite families to imagine new possibilities during The Rose Theater's 2024-25 season.

"As someone relatively new to this community, it is incredible to see a city lean into its values with its support of this theater. Children are the bedrock of our future, the cornerstones of our community, so to see a city value giving them transformative arts experiences is incredible. It makes Omaha stand out. I hear it from our peers across the country all the time," says Rose Artistic Director Matthew Gutschick.

The 2024-25 Rose season consists of five hour-long mainstage shows included with membership, along with three premium mainstage shows featuring larger casts, more complex staging and an overall enhanced theater experience with reserved seating and an intermission.

The 2024-25 season features a wide variety of characters who are empowered to face challenges and find solutions. As Gutschick explains, "We sought plays and musicals that make us laugh, that inspire us and that make us see ourselves in a new light. It is important that every child in our city sees themselves onstage at The Rose, and we hope to provide a season that does that."

Thanks to a generous donation from Ron & Chris Blumkin, 2024-25 Rose family memberships are available for a throwback price of just \$75 (regularly \$125), which includes four free tickets to six consecutive member shows, no matter when a family purchases a membership.

Individual tickets to *Diary of a Wimpy Kid* will be available on May 24; tickets to all other shows will be available to the general public on August 1, 2024.

A number of accommodations are made for audience members with exceptionalities, including American Sign Language interpretation for the Deaf and hard-of-hearing, audio description services for the blind, and sensory-friendly performances for families with neurodivergent children. Each show in the Rose season is carefully selected to present families with familiar favorites as well as innovative new stories. Productions are designed to engage young audiences and introduce them to a wide genre of artistic styles, helping them develop a lifelong love of the performing arts.

In particular, the 2024-25 season will offer audiences an unexpected journey of imagination. "Each of these productions will completely transform the stage so much between shows to fit these really different stories. Audiences are going to experience a journey full of surprises. Each time they walk through The Rose doors, audience members will be transported to a vibrant new world," says Gutschick.

The Rose remains dedicated to its mission of inspiring young people and their families to discover the magic of theater, to find their voices and enrich their communities. Central to this mission has always been the understanding that theater has the power to transform the community. As Gutschick explains, "We are seeing so much data on the link between screen time and the decline in the mental health of our society's children. The live performing arts are an antidote to this. I love the convenience of streaming *Bluey* at home with my son, but being connected to him at a theater event far eclipses anything we are able to do in front of a screen. He is more emotive, reacts more and seeks out connections with other people when we go to the theater. Those are all positive effects of taking your child to The Rose. It connects them to the world and to the possibilities of their imaginations."

"We believe theater is essential to helping children develop the skills they need to lead a successful, fulfilled life," says Gutschick. "This has been a core value from our early beginnings in 1949, and it is just as true 75 years later."

Young Coraline Jones has just moved with her parents into an old house and is bored by her colorless surroundings and her busy parents. She discovers a secret door that leads to a parallel world, but with one key difference: all the grownups have black buttons for eyes. This new world seems to offer all she wants: parents who are keenly interested in her, toys that sing and dance, neighbors who get her name right. But as this parallel world becomes increasingly unsettling, Coraline must learn the true meaning of bravery to save her parents and herself.

"Coraline is a resilient and compelling heroine. She wishes to find a family that connects more with one another," explain Gutschick. "She thinks she finds that in the fantastic parallel universe of the Other Mother. But Other Mother loves Coraline in a transactional way. Coraline has to fight for a more genuine form of affection."

With plans for audiences to engage in onstage costume parades and other spooky fun, *Coraline* will be a perfect addition to Halloween plans, according to Gutschick. "We wanted to embrace the vibes of a Mickey's Not-So-Scary Halloween and do something that families can enjoy in the leadup to the holiday," he says.

The 75-minute production of *Coraline* will be presented Oct. 11-27, 2024, with performances Fridays at 7 pm, Saturdays at 2 and 5 pm, and Sundays at 2 pm.

Inspired by the work of Omaha educator Dr. Ferial Pearson and written by Rose playwright-in-residence Brian Guehring, The Rose will bring **Secret Kindness Agents** to the stage in a world premiere production, Jan. 17 - Feb. 2, 2025. Pearson's Secret Kindness Agents Project has been implemented in over 500 schools around the world from preschool through university level.

"Dr. Pearson has had a long relationship with The Rose. She has generously shared her expertise with our staff for many years and her family has participated in Rose programming. When the idea of telling an original story about her *Secret Kindess Agents* came up, we were so grateful she said 'yes,'" says Gutschick.

In **Secret Kindness Agents**, when their school is overcome with the winter blues, excessive grumpiness, school testing stress, and an overall dark cloud of doom and gloom, Secret Agents Glitter Waffles, Chameleon, Stinger and Ringleader have been recruited to make a kinder place for all. Will these elementary school students succeed in their secret spy missions? Can they break the secret codes from headquarters? Will their secret agency be discovered? Will they make a difference in this school?

Secret Kindness Agents continues the legacy of Pearson's program. The idea behind Secret Kindness Agents, which Pearson has shared in a viral TEDx Talk and a book about the program, is to perform an anonymous act of kindness every day and spread kindness throughout the community. The program has been recognized by Teaching Tolerance Magazine, Lady Gaga's Born This Way Foundation, and Hallmark's Care Enough Initiative. It's been implemented in more than 350 schools, from preschool through University, throughout the United States and Canada.

Secret Kindness Agents will make its world debut on The Rose stage Jan. 17 - Feb. 2, 2025, with performances Fridays at 7 pm, Saturdays at 2 pm and 5 pm, and Sundays at 5 pm.

Milo Imagines the World is a collaboration with the Children's Theatre Company that brings the award-winning book by Matt de la Pena to life on The Rose stage.

"This show is from some of the best children's book authors in the world right now, Matt de la Peña and Christian Robinson, who also wrote *Last Stop On Market Street* and *Carmela Full of Wishes* together," says Gutschick. "It is based on Christian Robinson's personal story."

In the show, Milo is a young boy riding the train with his sister to visit their mom. Along the way, he creates vibrant fantasy worlds about each of the people he meets. He draws what he imagines their lives are like and those fantasies come to life onstage, like a boy he imagines is a king with a castle. This show features original music that covers genres from pop to blues.

"This is a quintessential "don't judge a book by its cover" show," says Gutschick. "Milo, in imagining what the lives of others are like, cannot fully appreciate their human complexity until the end of the piece when he learns something really important about one of his fellow train riders."

Milo Imagines the World will be presented Mar. 21 - Apr. 6, 2025, with performances Fridays at 7 pm, Saturdays at 2 pm and 5 pm, and Sundays at 2 pm. The show is expected to run approximately 50 minutes.

He's also already a really musical character, so we were excited to share this original story with music," says Gutschick.

Pete the Cat will bring its madcap antics to The Rose stage Apr. 18 - May 4, with performances Fridays at 7 pm, Saturdays at 2 pm and 5 pm, and Sundays at 2 pm. The show is expected to run approximately 60 minutes.



An underwater world of fantasy and adventure comes to The Rose with **Disney / Pixar's Finding Nemo TYA,** running June 6 - 29, 2025. The show is a vibrant, puppetry filled, musical adaptation of the beloved 2003 Pixar movie *Finding Nemo*.

Gutschick shares that The Rose's production will feature the talents of What If Puppets, the company that delighted audiences in last season's *Rudolph the Red-Nosed Reindeer*. "Almost every character in the show will be embodied by a puppet. This lets us embrace the magic of the underwater world Pixar/Disney created in the film *Finding Nemo*," he says.

In *Finding Nemo*, Marlin, an anxious and over-protective clownfish, lives in the Great Barrier Reef with his kid Nemo, who longs to explore the world beyond their anemone home. But when Nemo is captured and taken to Sydney, Marlin faces his fears and sets off on an epic adventure across the ocean. With the help of lovable characters such as optimistic Dory, laid-back sea turtle Crush, and the supportive Tank Gang, Marlin and Nemo both overcome challenges on their journey to find each other and themselves.

"This is a show based on my favorite Pixar film. I cry every time when Marlin is reunited with Nemo and tells his son about the sea turtles he met along his journey," says Gutschick.

Disney / Pixar's Finding Nemo will be presented June 6 - 29, 2025, with performances Fridays at 7 pm, Saturdays at 2 pm, and Sundays at 2 pm. The show is expected to run 90 minutes without an intermission.
