

The **Junior Rose Brigade** is a select group of musical theater performers in Grades 4-7 who hone their singing, dancing, and acting skills by performing a full 1-Hr Broadway Junior show in the fall, perform and compete at the Junior Theater Festival in Sacramento, CA in the winter, and curate a full performance showcase for their friends and family in the spring as well as perform at the Rose Theater Downtown for their year-end- musical theater concert!

EXPECTATIONS

- ★ Understand that the casting of roles will be based on the student's availability to attend rehearsals.
- Participate in rehearsal that includes (1) bathroom/drink break while engaging in the process as expected (i.e., good behavior, following directions, listening, approaching learning new choreography, songs, and characters with excitement and curiosity.)
- Wear jazz shoes and appropriate rehearsal wear (leggings, sweats, cami, leotard, t-shirt, etc.) for all rehearsals.
- ★ Understand there is "homework": memorizing lines, lyrics to songs, reviewing blocking, and choreography.
- A Participate in two (2) year-long dance, musical theater, and/or voice classes to further technique training.
- 🖈 Attend all mandatory performance dates.
- * Attend Junior Theater Festival in Sacramento, CA from February 7-9, 2025 with at least (1) caregiver.
- ★ Be in attendance for the final week of rehearsals before leaving for the Junior Theater Festival. No Cast members may leave early for JTF and miss rehearsals.
- Students are allowed only two (2) unexcused absences.
 - Excused absences are absences communicated before 72 hours of rehearsal to the Director and approved OR the student is sick from school that day.
