


Brian Guehring (PLAYWRIGHT) is the award winning Playwright in Residence of the Omaha Theater Company. Brian's recent scripts for the Rose have included Popularity Coach, Sherlock Holmes and the First Baker Street Irregular, The Mysterious Casefiles of Silver Cash Money Detective (school tour), Be Careful What You Wish For (summer youth production), and The Super Adventures of Nutrition

Man and Dr. Exercise (school tour). His plays have been produced by professional theaters for young audiences in Kentucky, Washington, D.C., South Carolina, Illinois, Florida, Michigan, Texas, Pennsylvania, Ohio, and Virginia in addition to productions by schools, universities, and community groups. His scripts The Brave Little Tailor, Stronger than Strong: Great American Tall Tale Heroines, The Bully Show, Sherlock Holmes and the First Baker Street Irregulars and King Chemo are published by Dramatic Publishing.

Brian is also an actor, youth director, and educator at the Rose. He has most recently has been seen on our stage as Mr. Salt in Charlie and the Chocolate Factory, Rabbit/Owl in Winnie the Pooh, Skipper the Penguin in Madagascar, Mr. Krahler in Diary of Anne Frank, and Lord Farquaad in Shrek. Brian is co-director of Pride Players and Rose Junior Brigade. Brian teaches the teen playwriting class on Saturdays here at the Rose. He also currently serves as literary manager for the theater.

In 2016, Brian was honored by the Children's Theater Foundation with the Orlin Corey Medallion Award for significant achievements for the enrichment of children in the United States and Canada through nurturing artistic work in theater and the arts. He was awarded a Lin Wright Special Recognition Award from the American Alliance for Theater and Education in 2013. Brian previously served on the national board of directors and executive committee of Theater for Young Audiences/USA and Pride Youth Theater Alliance. He earned his MFA in theater for young audiences from University of Texas at Austin and his BA in theater from Duke University.




Parking is no predicament at The Rose

Thanks to the Omaha Douglas Public Building Commission, Rose audience members can now park for just \$2 in the parking garage at 1910 Harney Street (the corner of 19th & Harney) on weekend show days. This convenient location across the street from The Rose allows families quick and easy access to the theater at an affordable price.

"The families visiting The Rose now have access to the closest parking facility -- literally just across the street to the southeast -- at a rate less than they would pay at other uncovered lots or at a parking meter.
