




I'm going to The Rose Theater, located in downtown Omaha! I'm going to see **Secret Kindness Agents**!

Once we get there, the outside of the theater will look like this:



As soon as we're ready, we'll go inside the building. Once we go through the doors we'll be in the lobby. Which looks like this:



The lobby is a large room where we get our tickets, use the restrooms, and wait for the auditorium doors to open.

I will wait patiently with my adult while we get our tickets.

Once we get our tickets, we'll either go through the auditorium doors from the lobby and find our seats






OR we might go upstairs and find our seats in the balcony. For this show, we get to pick our seats once we get inside the auditorium.

The theater is very large and has a lot of chairs.

There might we a lot of people waiting for the show to get started. I'll make sure to stay with my adult.



We can either wait in our seats for the show to start or we can also visit the "wiggle room" which is a classroom right off of the lobby. This room isn't as crowded or noisy as the auditorium or lobby might be.



If I need to go to the bathroom before, after, or during the show, I will let my adult know.

If we are sitting in the balcony, we'll go down the stairs and the bathrooms will be right there!





If we are sitting on the main floor, we'll go downstairs to the basement bathrooms. Before the show starts and once I've found my seat I can talk to the members in my group. But I must stay sitting and keep my hands and feet to myself.




Once the lights begin to dim and an announcement is played over the speakers I will know that the show is about to start. It's important to remember that even though the lights are getting darker and there may be a loud voice that I don't have to be scared; I am safe.



Once the show starts I will be a good audience member. This means I will be quiet and watch the stage. If at any point during the performance things get too loud or I need to take a break, I'll let my adult know and we can go to the wiggle room.






The performance will also be on a TV screen in the restless room.

We can stay in this room until I feel better.

Seeing a performance at a theater is like seeing a movie.



In live theater, the people performing will be right in front of me on stage. They are called actors.

Actors pretend they are characters to tell us a story. It's important to remember that while a character might be scary or mean, the actor playing them is really nice and it is just pretend.

In this play, the students have special "agent names" that are not their real names. These are fun, pretend names that help them feel excited about doing kind things for others. Some examples of agent names are Agent Glitter Waffles and Agent Chameleon. What would your agent name be?



The setting of this play is in a school. I will hear a school bell at different times during the show.



When Ms. Kedves, Agent Sunflower, first introduces the secret kindness project to Esme and Adeline they have to set the documents on fire. The fire is not real. I am safe.



When the secret kindness agents start training there is a blackout on stage. I am safe. The actors are safe. The lights will come right back on.



There is a part when everything in Alejandro's backpack falls out onto the floor. People walk by him and laugh. They are just acting and the agents know their secret kindness mission is about to begin!



When the agents have their naming ceremony and official oath there are blackouts on stage and thunder and lightning sound effects through the entire ceremony. The lights will come back on. If the storm sounds are too loud I can cover my ears or wear headphones.



At the end of the naming ceremony there is a loud horn sound. This is a congratulations sound. I can cover my ears or wear headphones if it is too loud.



When Agent Chameleon leaves nice notes on the students desk she has to use a distraction first. She uses a cup of plastic cat toys when it falls it makes a noise. Everyone is safe. If it is too loud I can cover my ears or wear headphones.



When the students are at recess Principal Bonner blows a whistle to signal the students to line up. I can cover my ears or wear headphones if I don't like the sound of the whistle.



When Agent Stinger takes Agent Ringleader to the nurse there is a blackout on stage. The lights will come right back on




When Ms. Senft cleans up the buddy bench sign and Agent Chameleon and Agent Glitter Waffles feel defeated, there is a blackout. The lights will come right back on.




When the secret kindness agents are getting ready to transform their school there is a blackout and swirling lights on stage. I can cover my eyes or use the sunglasses provided in the Rose Theater sensory kit. I can check out a sensory kit from the box office.



When the secret kindness agents are trying to hang up posters there is a red light on stage and a big sound. I can cover my eyes and ears or use headphones and sunglasses if the sounds and lights bother me. I am safe.





When the student council president, Elena, catches the kindness agents there are siren noises and moving lights. I can cover my eyes and ears or use headphones and sunglasses if the sounds and lights bother me.

At the end of the play there is loud music and flashing lights because they have a dance party! If this bothers me I can use headphones and sunglasses. I can also cover my eyes and ears.



In the final scene the lights are dim on stage. The actors are safe. I am safe. This is part of the dramatic effect.



Once curtain call is over, the lights will come up. I can leave with my adult, or I can stay for a question & answer session with a couple actors. We can also go up to the balcony lobby where I can meet a couple of the actors and get their autographs.



The question & answer session will take place in the theater. I can move and find a seat with my adult in the first couple of rows so I can be closer to the stage and ask the actors questions.

After the show is over I will leave The Rose. I can talk to my friends and family about all the fun things I saw in the show.
